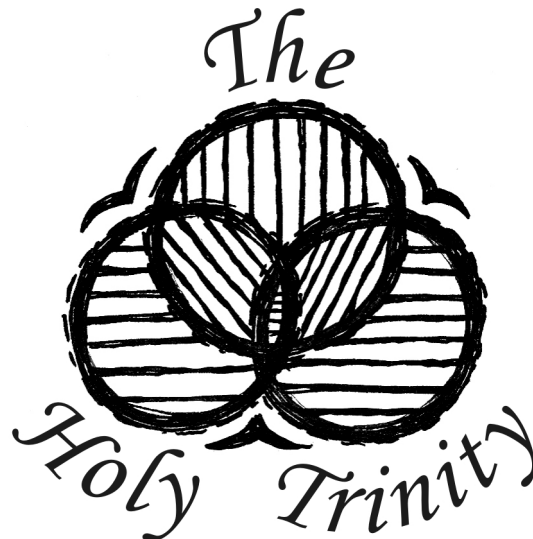


From the Pastor's Desk

The final stained glass windows were installed this past week in the chapel and meeting room. This means the installation of all the stained glass is complete in our new church. We hope to have someone write up a description of each window and other facts about our new church. This can be used as a handout for the many people who visit the church each day. This week the pew company replaced any cushions that had imperfections. The only remaining "construction" related work that has to be done inside the church is the baptismal font. We are still looking at different solutions to the damage the water is causing in the metal. Hopefully we will have a final solution in the next few weeks.

On the north side of the grounds you will see a Rosary in stones and a cross being erected. One of our parishioners, Spencer Coffin, is doing this as part of his Eagle Scout project in conjunction with our wonderful landscaping committee. We plan on having a Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha outdoor Rosary with flowers all around it. The cross in the center is the cross built for the dedication of the property and it was mounted on the steel framework as the church was being built.

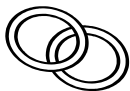
ALTAR SERVING OUTING
