Thankfully, the new north parking lot has been paved and is useable for Masses. This means we are no longer getting the exercise of walking from the south parking lot to the present Church building. There will be a handicap parking area near the new church as part of the north parking area, but that will be installed nearer the completion of the Church.

The real exciting news: They are starting to work on the steel. I have been told that the installation of the first couple of beams is critical to the whole structure, so it takes longer to install them. Once they are set, they will hopefully progress at a steady rate and we will be able to see the full dimensions of the new Church from the steel frame.

The interior design people are also starting to submit suggestions for the inside look of the Church. As some of their plans become more formalized, I will share them with you.
